

Lionville Youth Association Emergency Plan – all sports

There is an emergency medical center close to all fields on Rt. 100 in the Colonial Village Center. There are 4 hospitals that service our area – Paoli, Chester County, Phoenixville and Brandywine...20 minutes to each.

Injury – simple

1. Get First Aid Kit in JOBOX and give it to a parent or guardian if in attendance.
2. Have child hold bandage or ice to injury.
3. Apply Band Aid or bee stinger vile if appropriate. Take no other first aid action.
4. Notify parent of injury.

All other injuries

1. Ask for professional medical help amongst spectators.
2. Get parent on field
3. Do not move player
4. Call Ambulance – Have a lookout to direct ambulance to site.
5. Get accident statement from both coaches.
6. File injury report (form on website: www.chesco.com/~lya)
7. Follow up with phone call to home.

General Rules

1. Check all fields before games to determine playability. Cancel when necessary.
2. Suspend games and remove players at first sign of lightning. Have players seek shelter in automobiles only.
3. Check fields for safe conditions before returning to fields. Cancel game if unplayable. Rule of thumb – If you can't walk on it – you can't play on it.
4. Ask any person causing a disturbance in the stands to leave the park. Call 911 if any disturbance arises that you can not handle in a proper way.
5. Report any poor field conditions or bees/hornets nests near playing fields to sports commissioner. Never leave the field after the game while a child is without a parent or leave them unattended.
